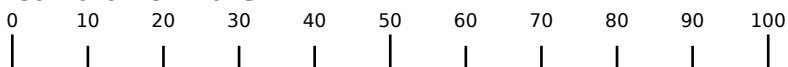


PRINTABLE RING SIZER

VINTAGE JEWELRY · Authentic European vintage & estate jewelry

1. Print this page at exactly 100%. Turn off 'fit to page' and any page scaling.
2. Check the calibration ruler below against a real ruler. It must measure exactly 100 mm.
3. Cut out the strip along its outer line, then cut the short dashed slot at the left end.
4. Wrap the strip around the base of your finger and pass the pointed end through the slot.
5. Pull snug, then read your size where the strip meets the slot.
6. Measure at the end of the day at room temperature, and measure twice.

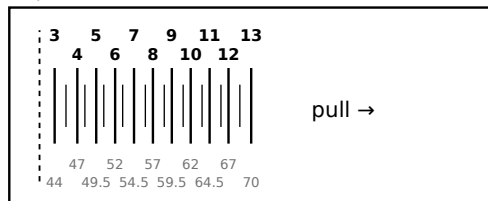
Calibration ruler



This line is 0 to 100 millimeters. If it does not measure 100 mm, your printer is scaling.

Ring size strip

Top numbers = US size · Bottom numbers = EU size (inner circumference in mm)



cut here

Half sizes are the shorter ticks between the numbered marks.

Accurate to roughly a quarter size. Measuring the inner diameter of a ring you already own is more precise.

Wide bands wear tighter: add a quarter to a half size for bands over about 5 mm.
